

Persons interested in applying for the Senior Citizen Shared Ride Program can pick up an application at the FACT Transit Center or call 724-628-RIDE to have one mailed to you. When applying, you will need one of the following forms of documentation to verify proof of age:

- birth certificate
- valid motor vehicle operator's license
- baptismal certificate/other church record
- armed forces discharge/separation papers
- pace identification
- passport/naturalization papers
- PennDOT non drivers license I.D. card
- veterans universal access I.D. card (if date of birth is listed)
- · resident alien card
- A statement of age from social security administration.

"Facts" about Shared Ride

Shared Ride transportation is available to all residents of Fayette County. However, clients are encouraged to utilize public transportation wherever possible.

 The SW PA Area Agency on Aging, Inc. provides further subsidy so that persons 60 years and older ride FREE of charge to senior centers, adult day care centers, and respicenters.

To avoid charge, cancellations *must* be called into the FACT office at least two (2) hours in advance of the scheduled appointment time.

Eligibility for Shared Ride transportation must be determined by a representative of the FACT office. Once eligibility is determined, then, the client may schedule trips by contacting the FACT office.

Transportation services will be provided between the hours of 7:00 AM to 1:00 PM within Fayette County only on Sundays only and 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM Monday-Saturday within service area. Trips to Allegheny County on Wednesday and Thursday.

Reservations must be made at least one (1) business day in advance of the scheduled trip and before the (2) two o'clock hour.

The call taker will give you a pick-up time and instruct you to be ready a half an hour before and a half an hour after your scheduled pick-up time.

* FACT shall provide transportation services to *all* individuals regardless of race, disability, age, sex, or religion.

The FACT staff will inform the client of the fare required for the trip when all arrangements are being made. It is the responsibility of the carrier to establish a procedure for collecting the fare.

Only clients pre-scheduled by the FACT office will be transported under this program.

Clients will only be transported to destinations which have been pre-authorized by the FACT office.

Client Responsibilities

Clients 65 and older will pay *only* 15% of the full fare. However, SW Area Agency on Aging will pay 10% for a medically necessary appointment for individuals 65 years of age and older. Thus, the client will be responsible to pay the remaining 5% of the fare.

The PA Department of Transportation will reimburse 85% of all fares. Clients are responsible for the remaining 15% upon boarding.
