

Intellectual Disability Services

Agency with Choice Intermediary Service Organization (ISO)

A provider agency is contracted by an individual or their representative to act as the employer of record for a support worker. The individual or their representative is an active participant in the development of the job responsibilities for the support worker as well as the support worker's hiring or firing, scheduling, and training.

Community Habilitation

Community habilitation is provided in an Adult Training Facility and offers individual assistance and training in the areas of daily living skills, pre-vocational skills and community involvement while also providing recreational and social opportunities

Family Driven-Family Support Services (FSS)

FSS offers individuals living independently, or with their families, the opportunity to purchase items to enhance their ability to remain in the home and increase community integration skills. Services that can be purchased include respite care, sitter/companion service, homemaker service, in-home therapy, family education/training activities.

Home and Community Habilitation

Home and Community Habilitation services provide individuals and/or their family with assistance in keeping the individual or family member at home while increasing their independence in the community. Services can include sitter/aide services, respite care and home adaptations.

Life Sharing through Family Living

Life Sharing through Family Living provides the opportunity for an individual to reside and participate as a member of a family. The family provides assistance with their daily living needs and the individual shares in various life experiences such as birthdays, weddings, graduations, etc.

Pre-Vocational Services

Pre-Vocational Services are designed to assist persons in establishing and achieving their highest level of social and vocational performance with the goal of securing meaningful employment.

Residential Services

Residential services are provided in homes and apartments located within the community. Supports are offered based on individual need and range from 24/7 arrangements to minimal assistance.

Specialized Therapies

Specialized therapies including speech therapy, physical therapy, occupational therapy, nursing services, and behavior management delivered by a health/behavior professional.

Supported Living

Supported Living provides residential supports to an individual living in his/her own home or apartment to help insure that the skills necessary for independent living (such as budgeting, house cleaning and the scheduling of medical appointments) are maintained.

Supports Coordination

Supports Coordination is a service that is provided to all individuals registered with an intellectual disability. A Supports Coordinator is assigned to assist the individual and family in locating, coordinating and monitoring community services that support their everyday needs and insure their health and safety.

Transitional Work Services

Transitional Work Services includes supervision in a work setting to assist with and oversee all aspects of work performance.
